

Dr. Dimitris Kiritsis is Faculty Member at the School of Engineering of EPFL, the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Lausanne, Switzerland, leading the research group on Closed Loop Lifecycle Management. He is also Guest Professor at the Intelligent Maintenance Systems Center of the University of Cincinnati, USA, and Invited Professor at the University of Technology of Compiègne (UTC), the University of Technology of Belfort-Montbéliard and at ParisTech Arts & Métiers - ENSAM in Paris, France.
